

CITY TOUR & CANAL (HALF DAY)

This excursion takes visitors on a tour of the main attraction of Panama City. It begins with a panoramic tour along the Cinta Costera, overlooking the Pacific Bay with views of the modern skyline.

We then visit Casco Antiguo, the city's historic quarter built in 1673, for a tour of the cobblestone streets and picturesque squares framed by colonial architecture. Sites include the San Jose Church and it's the Altar de oro, Plaza de Francia, Paseo Esteban Huertas, Las Bóvedas (the Vaults) and the Obelisk, which commemorates France's efforts and losses during the construction of the Panama Canal.

We continue on to the Miraflores Locks to observe the Canal operations and transiting ships (subject to Canal Administration itinerary). The tour concludes with a drive along the Causeway, which connects four small islands to the mainland, and a visit to the Crafts Market and Duty Free Zone.



INCLUDED: Ground transportation, guide, Tickets admission for the Panama Canal and freshments.

The facilities include a ship simulator where you can experience a virtual journey through the Panama Canal, a museum on the Panama Canal expansion and an observation deck over the canal locks.

We then head to the Causeway Islands to the Duty Free Shop, followed by the Crafts Market and a delicious lunch.

The next stop is Panama Viejo, the first city founded on the isthmus in 1519 and sacked by pirate Henry Morgan in 1670, for a visit of the Cathedral Tower.

We then drive to Casco Antiguo, Panama City's old quarter and home to colonial buildings, cobblestone streets, the presidency of the Republic, the San Jose Church and its Altar de oro and churches like San Felipe de Neri and other places.

CITY TOUR – A TRIP THROUGH PANAMA CITY

As soon as we left the hotel we were dazzled by the modernity of the architecture and the contrasts between the skyscrapers that crown the Cinta Costera, the width of the ocean, and the line of boats waiting to cross the Panama Canal on the horizon.

We will visit the banking district and the commercial area on the way to the Casco Antiguo (old town)

In Casco Antiguo, experience the charm of Panama City's old quarter with its cobblestone streets and colonial architecture. We will visit La Merced Church and its religious museum, walk the Las Bóvedas vaults and Paseo General Esteban Huertas located along the old fortress wall and once home to the royal household, the Supreme Court and the prisons, and today a prime vantage point for panoramic views of the modern skyscraper city and the Cinta Costera viaduct.



We then continue on to the Plaza de Francia to view the plaques commemorating the fallen heroes and builders of the French Canal, followed by the Interoceanic Canal Museum for an educational tour of Panama Canal planning, construction and operations. Across the way is the Metropolitan Cathedral with its mother of pearl spires and the old bells brought from Panama Viejo, the first city founded on the isthmus in 1519. Legend has it that Spaniards built escape tunnels located under the church.

We started our trip, making a tour to the Cinta Costera, where we will appreciate the Pacific Bay and the dazzling skyscrapers of this modern city of Panama, on the way to the Panama Canal to impress us with the engineering work of the beginning of the century.

From Panama City, we depart for the Miraflores Visitor Center, located on the east side of the Miraflores Locks an ideal vantage point from which to observe the Canal operations, a magnificent engineering feat of the early 20th century. Here, we'll watch the opening and closing of the locks as the ships begin or end their transit through the Canal.



CANAL TRANSIT (Partial Transit)

We invite you to discover the Eighth Wonder of the World from an unparalleled perspective: aboard a boat!

This excursion begins with ground transportation to the village of Gamboa and Gatun Lake, home to the Dredging Division of the Panama Canal Authority (ACP) facilities. We begin our boat tour of the Canal, through the Culebra Cut, built across the Continental Divide and where the Chagres River flows into the Canal. Here, the Operation of the Canal begins, and we navigate to the Pedro Miguel Locks and observe the work on the Panama Canal expansion project. Once at the Pedro Miguel Locks, the ship is lowered 9 meters to the Miraflores Lake, which we will pass through to reach the Miraflores Locks, where the ship is lowered 18 meters in two stages to the Pacific Ocean. From there, the ship navigates to the Flamenco Marina where we disembark.

The tour may take the reverse order, departing Miraflores to Gamboa, based on the recommendations of the Panama Canal Authority.

INCLUDED: Ground and sea transportation, guide, refreshments and lunch.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Light clothes, comfortable shoes, sunscreen, hat and sunglasses.

- Schedule depends on the duration of the transit through the locks, with a variation of up to two hours.

THREE CITIES – A TRIP THROUGH 3 CITIES

Panama can be divided in three cities: Panama la Viejo, Colonial and Modern. On this tour we will discover each of these cities attractiveness and enchantment.

We begin our tour at Panama La Vieja: the first city founded on the isthmus in 1519, and sacked by Pirate Henry Morgan in 1670; we can admire the city's ruins among which stands out The Cathedral Tower, with a height of 30m has been architecturally intervened to serve as a lookout point for visitors. Panama La Vieja was declared a historic monument by UNESCO in 1976, and few years later as a World Heritage Site.

We then continue our tour to Panama City's Casco Antiguo: This city was founded after the first one was destroyed. Here we will observe a colonial architecture, stroll through cobblestone streets, visit the Presidency of the Republic, the San Jose Church and its Altar de oro (Golden Altar), Plaza Francia and its Obelisk, San Felipe de Neri church and walk through El Paseo del General Esteban Huertas in order to get to The Bóvedas (Vaults).

Finally we head to the Modern City driving along La Calzada de Amador (Causeway), this artificial land was made to connect 3 small islands with the mainland where we'll visit the crafts market and duty free zone; our tour concludes at La Cinta Costera where we will embrace a panoramic view of the Skyscrapers that crown the ocean and makes this a modern city.

ECO CANAL & SUMMIT MUNICIPAL PARK (Monkey Island)

This beautiful adventure takes visitors on a scenic tour of the Panama Canal watershed and the wildlife of Lake Gatun, accompanied by a naturalist guide.

We will explore some of the islands that were created from hilltops after the artificial lake (the world's largest) was formed. This 60-minute boat tour is ideal for nature lovers as we can observe a variety of wildlife in a magnificent setting of tropical plants, trees and endemic and foreign species, introduced during the construction of the canal.

On the way back, we will visit the Summit Municipal Park, "a jewel within the Soberanía National Park", created in 1923 by the former Panama Canal Company as an experimental farm to test the adaptation of species and plants from around the world to Panama's tropical climate.

In the zoo, we will see a great variety of native and foreign species including the harpy eagle, Panama's national bird.



INCLUDED: Ground transportation from the hotel to Gamboa, water transportation (boat with capacity for 15-20 people each) from Gamboa to Monkey Island, entrance to Summit Park and visit to the Harpy Eagle educational center, guide and refreshments.

AERIAL TRAM & GATUN EXPEDITION

This will be an unforgettable experience! Situated in the heart of the jungle and along the Panama Canal, the village of Gamboa offers visitors an up close and personal experience with nature.

The tour begins with an aerial tram ride through the treetops to the Observation Tower for breathtaking panoramic views of the tropical rainforest, its flora and fauna and Lake Gatun. We will visit the orchid gardens and the butterfly exhibit, the aquarium and ranarium.

We then take a boat ride through the waters of the Panama Canal, navigating between the islands that were formed from hilltops when Lake Gatun was created. This area is a natural sanctuary for native species including sloths, swallows, toucans, crocodiles and turtles that inhabit the lush vegetation of the area.

Enjoy a buffet lunch in the “Los Lagartos” restaurant on the banks of the Chagres River with picturesque views across the river.

EMBERAS INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY

The indigenous Embera-Wounaan Community is located in a natural reserve between the Darien National Park and the Chagres National Park on the banks of major rivers tributaries of the Canal watershed. The area is a tropical paradise, rich in a diversity of vegetation and wildlife and home to one of Panama's indigenous communities: Parará Purú or Embera Drua.

The tour departs with ground transportation to the dock on the San Juan River, where we board a pirogue (canoe) and travel downstream to the indigenous village where we will share in its history, culture and customs, including folk dances, a crafts display of natural fiber baskets and cocobolo wood and tagua nut carvings, and a typical lunch of fish, cassava and plantains, prepared by the community and served on banana leaves. The leader of the community will explain the medicinal use of some of the forest plants, and you can experience the ceremonial tattooing of geometric and animal shapes with jagua (vegetable seed). At the end of the day, the river and a spectacular waterfall await, perfect for a refreshing dip in natural pools in a stunning jungle setting (weather permitting).

INCLUDED: Ground transportation, river-crossing in a motorized pirogue, donation to the community and the park, typical lunch, fruit, soft drinks (soda), snacks and traditional tattoo.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Comfortable clothes, sport shoes or wet shoes, sunscreen, sunglasses, swimsuit, beach towel, additional change of clothes and repellent.


