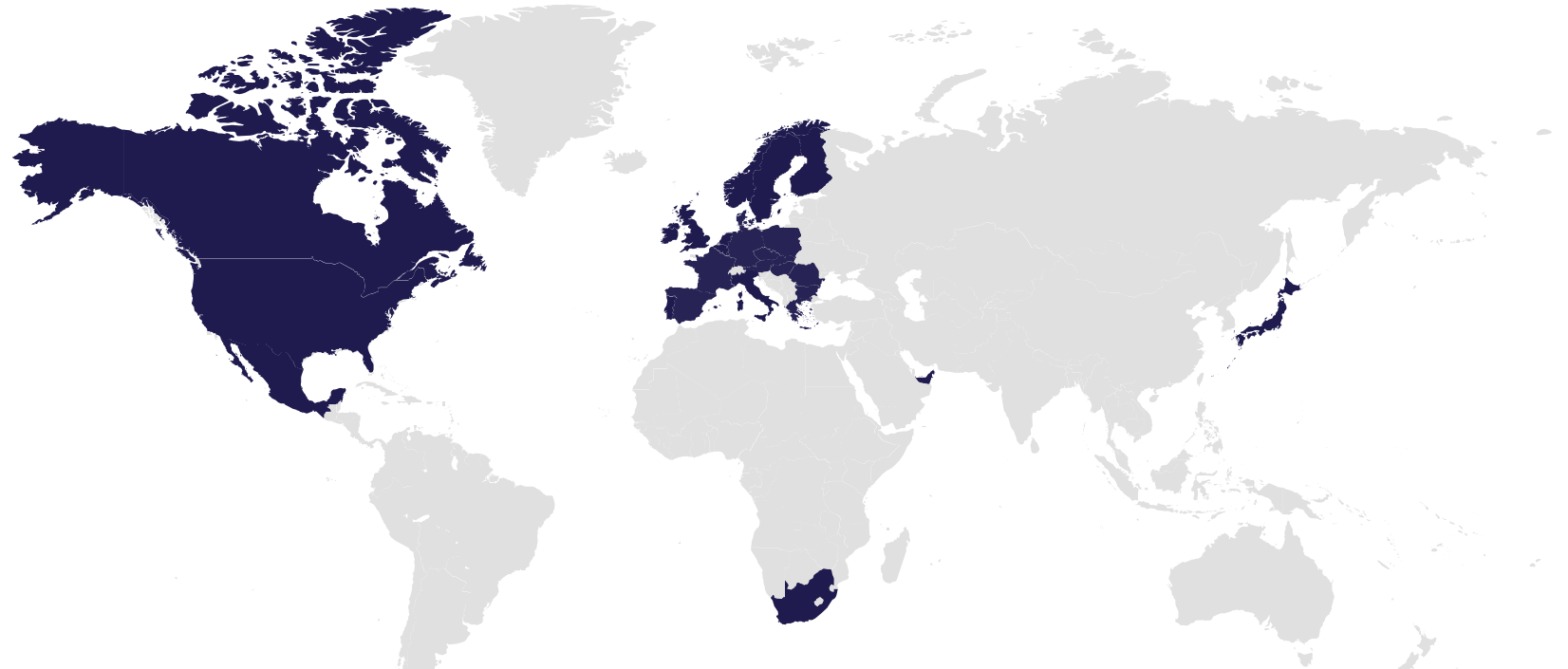

# Update on ICS2 ENS and GB Safety and Security



## ICS2 ENS

- Pre arrival Entry Summary Declaration required for goods entering the EU
- Applies across air, ocean, road, and rail
- Filing responsibility shared across carriers, forwarders, and partners
- Data must be submitted before loading or arrival, depending on mode
- Missing or incorrect filings lead to delays, screening, or holds
- Requires clear ownership and coordination across the network



## GB Safety and Security

- Entry Summary Declaration required for all goods imported into Great Britain
- Mandatory from 31 January 2025 for EU and non EU imports
- Supports advance risk assessment for border security
- Carrier legally responsible: shipping line or haulier/truck
- Requires detailed and accurate goods information before arrival
- Non compliance can result in delays, refusal of entry, or penalties

**Same requirement across regions: complete, accurate data before the shipment moves**

# MPCI (Maritime Pre-Load Cargo Information) is an Advance Manifest Filing

- UAE is the latest to implement a security filing – **Go Live July 31, 2025, grace period ends 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026**
- Direct UAE ocean freight & transit - MPCI filing required
- Filing deadline:
  - **24 hours** before commencement of loading at port of origin for HBLs
  - **6 hours** before commencement of loading at port of origin for MBLs
- Every HBL issuer must work with a UAE agent - UAE Agent is liable
- Declare cargo and HBL particulars

# Which cargoes require MPCl filing?

## Required:

All cargoes moving to or via UAE territory:

- Containerized maritime shipments discharged in the UAE (import, transit)-- filing by forwarders and shipping lines
- Freight remaining on board (FROB) and transshipments-- filing by shipping lines

## Cargoes out of scope:

Non-containerized cargo:

- Bulk cargo (dry, liquid and breakbulk)
- Ro/Ro
- Export shipments
- Empty containers

- Vessel 2 – NYC to Hamburg

# Consequences for non-compliance

- Financial penalties for late submissions, missing filings or incorrect data
- Enforcement actions and fines for loading cargo without ACT (Assessment Complete) message
- Carriers may begin to issue “Do Not Load” orders for non-compliance
- Shipment interception or detention upon arrival in the UAE

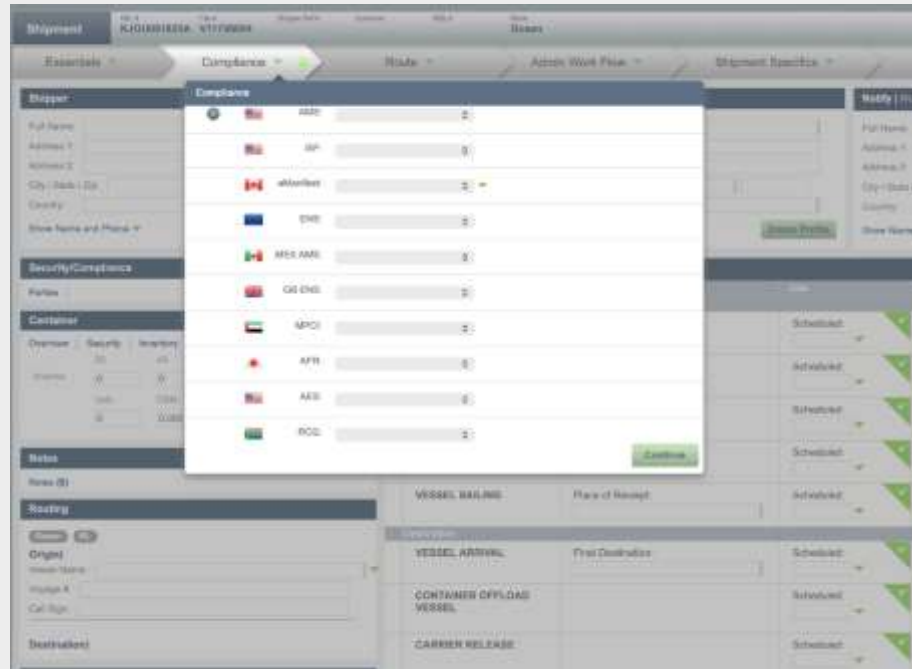
